A strong personal climbing background showing variety in different areas .

The delivery of other site specific training or mountain training awards is also advantageous.

Business Plan

The set up costs of the Boulder setter are around £1000 - £1500 with 3 to 4 Impact drivers and a selection of Ladders and PPE required .

The business plan should include the geographical location you intend to run your courses. With named walls you maybe affiliated to.

Mountain Training Qualification

As you will be responsible for the supervision of our course participants in an indoor bouldering environment you will be required to hold the Foundation coach as a minimum.

Level 3 Education & Training

To ensure the highest level of teaching on our courses we require our providers to hold the L3 Education & Training Certificate as a minimum. This course is delivered nationwide in a variety of methods included blended and distance learning.

A strong personal climbing background showing variety in different areas .

The delivery of other site specific training or mountain training awards is also advantageous.

Business Plan

The set up costs of the roped setter are around £5000 - £6000 with providers needing to have 6 full sets of access kit for participants plus a set for yourself as the instructor.

The business plan should include the geographical location you intend to run your courses. With named walls you maybe affiliated to.

Mountain Training Qualification

As you will be responsible for the supervision of our course participants in an indoor lead climbing environment you will be required to hold the CWDI as a minimum.

Level 3 Education & Training

To ensure the highest level of teaching on our courses we require our providers to hold the L3 Education & Training Certificate as a minimum. This course is delivered nationwide in a variety of methods included blended and distance learning.
